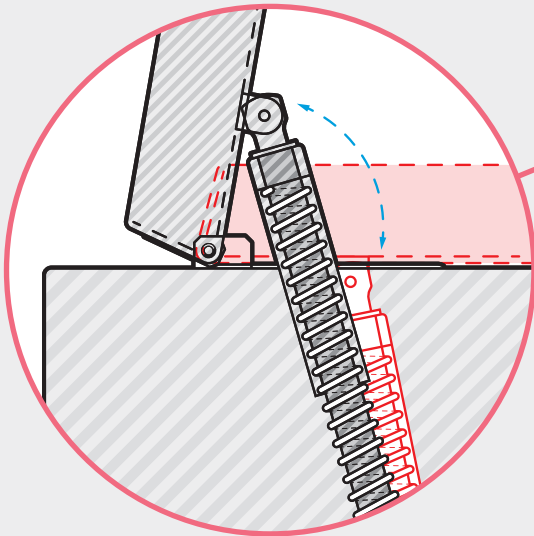
Tested for Robustness

As one example of our rigorous test regimes, the electrical lid system (drive, hinge, and lock) is cycled far beyond typical daily use to verify reliable performance over many years.

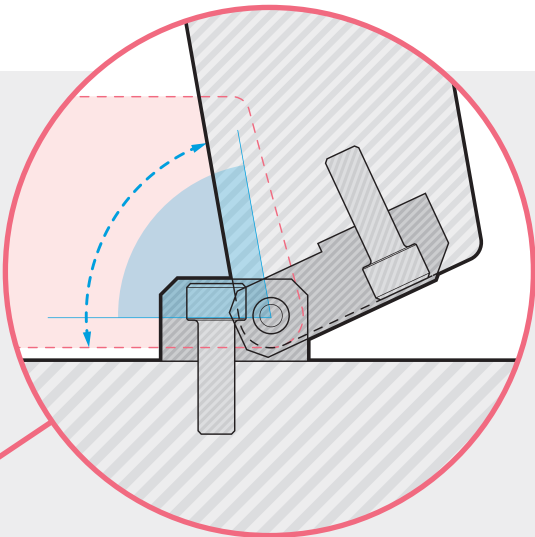

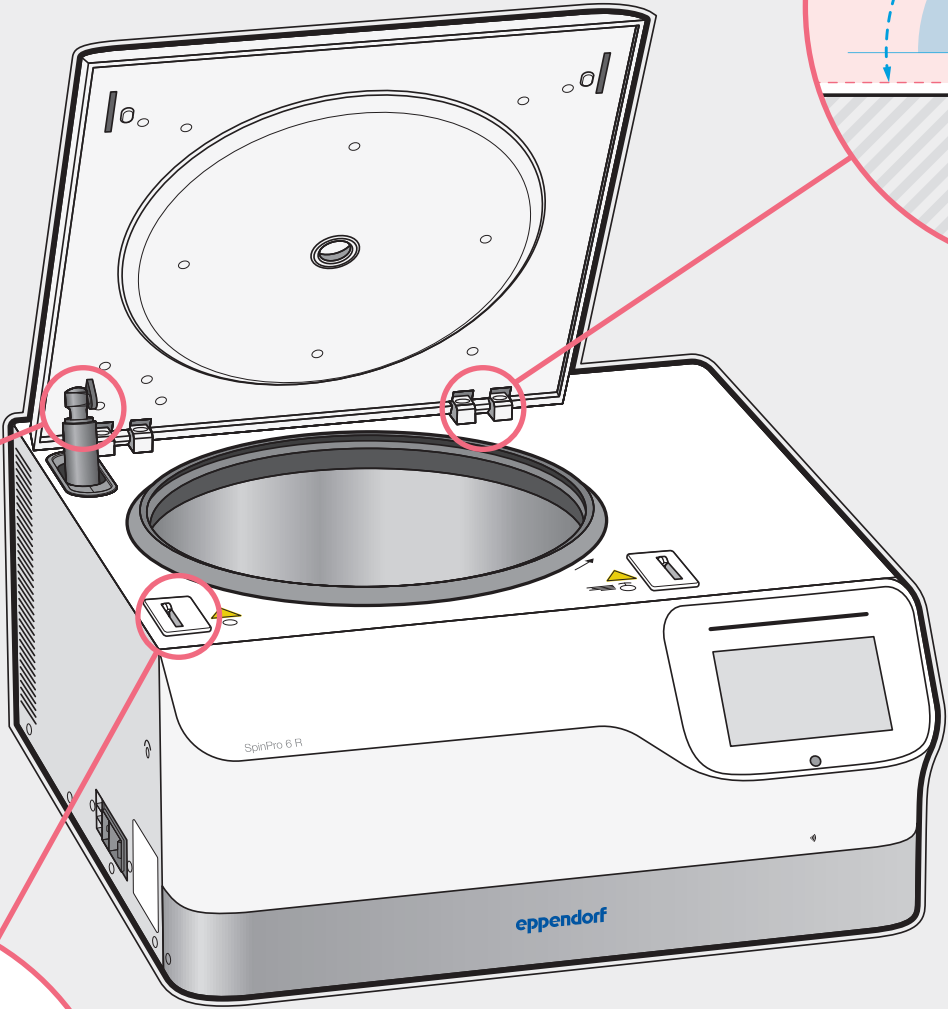
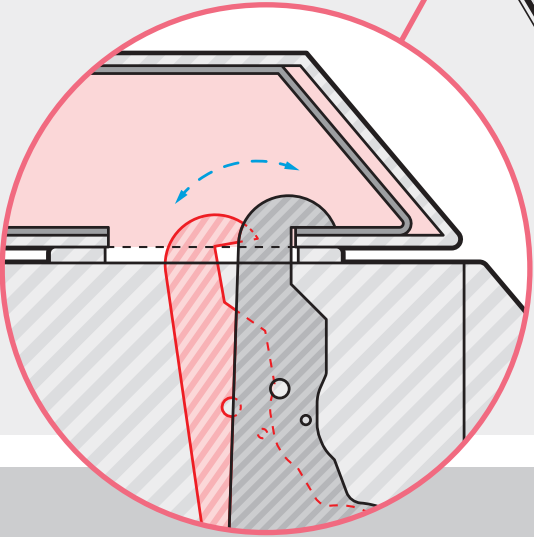
